The Sailing Circle: 19th Century Seafaring Women from New York, is a collaborative exhibit produced by the Three Village Historical Society and the Cold Spring Harbor Whaling Museum.

The Sailing Circle features wives who went to sea with their captain husbands on deep-water merchant, whaling ships and coasting vessels. The exhibit includes objects, artifacts and prints from the collections of the two sponsoring institutions as well as the Oysterponds Historical Society, the William Steeple Davis Trust, several New England museums and a number of private Long Island collectors.
