Guests will learn about some of Long Island's most haunted spaces including Raynham Hall, Mount Misery, Sweet Hollow Road, Old Bethpage Village, The Caleb Smith House, and other local sites. LISPR will share sound clips of ghostly voices captured in public places around Long Island.
