On Monday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, **Dr. Frank Turano** and Three Village Historical Society archivist **Karen Martin** will be the guest speakers at the Three Village Historical Society's monthly lecture, located in the Community Room of the Emma S. Clark Memorial Library, 120 Main Street, Setauket, NY. Their lecture topic: "**Life Along the Shores of the Three Villages: Subsistence to Enterprise to Leisure.**" Artifacts and historical photographs from the Three Village Historical Society's collection will provide a look at everyday life from the 17<sup>th</sup> century through the early 20<sup>th</sup> century.

Frank Turano, Ph.D., is a Research Assistant Professor in the Department of Ecology and Evolution at Stony Brook University. He is Co-Vice President of the Three Village Historical Society.

Karen Martin is archivist for the Three Village Historical Society's archival collection. The collection includes documents, photographs, and artifacts from the 17<sup>th</sup> century through present. The collection is available to researchers, by appointment, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
