George Washington's Long Island Spy Ring

Comes to Your Classroom!

The Long Island Spy Kit includes an educator's guide and a variety of colorful resources to foster creative thinking in history classrooms. It was developed after Stony Brook University purchased two letters written on 24th September 1779 and 16th September 1780 by General George Washington to his Chief of Intelligence, Major Benjamin Tallmadge. The letters make clear Washington's close direction of Long Island's Culper Spy Ring that proved to be instrumental in winning the American Revolution. The Long Island Spy Kit and accompanying Teachers Guide enhance the core history curriculum with materials and lessons highlighting the fascinating activities of Long Island spies during the British occupation from 1776-1783.

The Long Island Spy Kit's contents include:

- **Facsimiles of the letters** and suggestions on how to use **them** with students
- **Replicas of artifacts** used by the spies and by George Washington
- **2'x3' wall maps** of lower Manhattan, Long Island, and spy routes
- **Costumes and vignettes** suitable for student performance
- **Teachers Guide** with classroom-ready activities and DBQs that integrate **Social Studies/ELA skills**.

The Long Island Spy Kit:

is appropriate for all educational settings, including public and private schools and home schooling. It is available upon request from the **Three Village Historical Society**. **The materials may be borrowed for up to three weeks**, depending upon demand/availability.

Fee:\$200 for the first class presentation, \$100 for each additional class with a 4 class limit per day.
